

MANN GIRL DEAD - Miss Pearl Agnes Mann Dies After Long Illness from Consumption - Burial Tomorrow - At Reynolds Cemetery - Died at the Home of Her Sister.

Miss Pearl Agnes Mann, who yesterday afternoon died at the home of her sister, Mrs. Quillan Buffenbarger on Cross Street, was well known in this vicinity. She has suffered for many months from consumption in its worst stage and succumbed after fighting a heroic battle against death.

The deceased was born in this city September third, 1889, and until their death she lived with her parents, Mr. and Mrs. Ashley Mann. After the demise of her parents, she took up her abode with Mrs. Buffenbarger, and has since lived with her. She was taken ill from lung trouble some time ago and consumption afterward developed and all hopes were abandoned for her recovery months ago. The Funeral services will be held from the house tomorrow at 2 o'clock and interment will be made at the Reynolds cemetery. A host of friends and relatives survive to mourn the departure of this well known girl.
