Retired Farmer Dies At County Hospital – Van Guilder Funeral Tuesday Afternoon.

Chauncey Van Guilder, 83, retired farmer, who resided at 826 Winchester street, died at 11 o'clock Sunday night at the Adams county memorial hospital after a three weeks illness of complications. He was a native of Pennsylvania and had lived in Adams County for the past 29years. He was a member of the First United Brethren church of this city.

Surviving are the wife, Mary, three step-daughters and three step-sons. Funeral services will be held at 3 o'clock Tuesday afternoon at the Gillig & Doan funeral home, with Rev. R. R. Wilson officiating. Burial will be in the Reynolds cemetery. The body may be viewed at the funeral home until time of the services.
