In the name of God Amen I Elizabeth
Marriage of Henricks County Indiana
being weak in body but of sound and perfect
mind and memory and blessed be God
Almighty for the same - - -

do make and publish this my last will and
testament in the manner and form as
following (that is to say) I give and bequeath
~~up~~ unto my dear and beloved Father and
Mother Daniel & Dolly Higgins one
half quarter land lying in the County and State
as here mentioned being the only piece of land
the said Elizabeth Marriage has any claim
to, and all the personal estate goods and
chattels of what kind and nature whatsoever
they may be I give and bequeath the same
to my dear beloved Father and Mother
so long as either of them may live
and at the death of my last surviving
parents if any of the personal property or
land should remain yet in their possession
I bequeath that it be equally divided between
all my brothers but for my Father to have
the ~~use~~ sole use and control of all to see or
use it in any way for his benefit I hereby
appoint my Father sole executor of this my
last will and testament hereby revoking all for-
mer wills by me made in witness whereof

Know all men by these presents that we Daniel
Higgins Thomas Higgins John Higgins and
David Higgins are held and firmly bound
unto James Donnard and Samuel Jessup of
said judges of Hendricks County and their suc-
cessors in Office in the sum of Five hundred dol-
lars lawful money of the United States, the pay-
ment of which well and truly to be made
as Witness our Hands and seals, this 27th day
of July 1829

The condition of the above obligation is such
that when as the above bounden Daniel Higgins
is executor of the last will and Testament of
Elizabeth Aldridge deceased, now should the said
Daniel Higgins well and truly discharge the duties
of his Office as executor aforesaid, and well and
truly pay over all monies which may come in
to his hands by virtue of his appointment
as aforesaid, to those entitled by law to demand
and receive the same, and do such other acts and
things as the law requires, then and in other
case, the above obligation to be void and of
none effect otherwise to remain in full force and
virtue.
