all inhabitants of the State of Indiana, are held and firmly bound unto the State of Indiana, in the penal sum of *One hundred* dollars, for the payment of which, well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors, and administrators, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents, sealed with our seals and dated, this *3rd* day of *February* A. D. 18*53*. Whereas the above named and bounden *Job Hadley* has

been duly appointed by the Court of Common Pleas *Hendricks County* Probate Court of the County of *in the State aforesaid,* GUARDIAN of the persons and estates of *Sarah K. Appleby and Elizabeth A. Appleby,*

and letters of Guardianship have been duly granted to *him* by said *Clerk Court*. Now therefore the condition of the above obligation, is to the effect following to-wit: That the said *Job Hadley* shall faithfully perform the duties of *his* said trust as such Guardian: Then and in that case said obligation shall be null and void, otherwise to be and remain in full force and virtue in law.
