The Administrator further shows to the court that on the sale of note of Thomas Dugan with Henry Dugan as surety he sustained a net loss of \$29.⁵³ from the face of said note as follows:
At the time of the execution of said note the surety was considered as being good and he accepted the surety after consultation with those whom he thought to be advised as to his real

condition. After the execution of said note various judgments were rendered against the surety and his bonded them. The principal became insolvent. There was no way to make the money but by furnishing money and redeeming bonds from sale. After full consideration with the disintegrator, and John T. 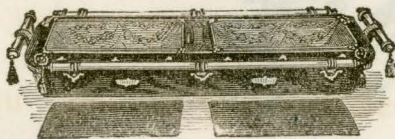
