Richard Arnold late of said county, together with
Jacob Stark *Seth Guinn* *Ugilla Jordan* *Benjamin Swa*
grasp James *Care* *John Littleman* *Milton Guinn* *North Fite*
master and *Robert Toles* all late of said county on
the first day of October in the year Eighteen hundred and
forty six with fire and arms in said county did then and
there unlawfully riotously and tumultuously ac-
tually do an unlawful act of violence to wit drive
them and there unlawfully riotously and
tumultuously tear down and move a certain ~~house~~
house then and there being on the land of one
Elizabeth Walker there situate

contrary to the form of the statute in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the
