of which well and truly to be made and done we bind
ourselves our heirs executors and administrators jointly and
severally firmly by these presents. Sealed with our seals and
dated this 15th day of May A.D. 1838

The Condition of the above obligation is such that if the
above bound Aaron Harding will truly and faithfully
discharge the duties and perform the trusts committed
to him as Guardian of the person and estate of Martha
Ann Ashren during the minority of the said Martha Ann
Ashren and render to this court a just and true account
of his said Guardianship when he shall be thereto required
then the above obligation is to be void and of none effect
otherwise to be and remain in full force and virtue in Law.
