said Court at the Term aforesaid to make partition
of Lots number four (4) and five (5) in Block num-
ber nineteen (19) in the Town of Danville, ^{formerly belonging to the heirs of Ralph Croft Dec'd} between
John Baker and Samuel McWhorter and others by afi-
gning and setting over to said John Baker three
Eleventh parts of the lots aforesaid after having been
duly sworn in open Court, upon actual view of the
premises do assign and set over to the said John
Baker and to his heirs forever for his portion and
part of said lots thirty three feet six inches in front
on the north side of said lot five (5) extending back
the full length of said lot the same width
