I now all men by these presents, that we
Jesse Ballard, Uriah Ballard and Charles
Vertrees are held and firmly bound unto
the State of Indiana, in the sum of five hundred
dollars, for the payment of which we and
truly to be made and done, we bind ourselves,
our heirs, executors, and administrators, jointly
and severally, firmly by these presents.

Sealed with our seals, and dated this
10th day of November A.D. 1838

The condition of the
above obligation is such, that if the above
bound Jesse Ballard will truly and faithfully
discharge the duties and perform the
trusts committed to him as guardian of the
person and estate of Amanda Ballard infant
daughter of Mary Carson late Mary Ballard
of the County of Hendricks and State
of Indiana deceased, during the minority of the
said Amanda Ballard, and render to this
Court a just and true account of his guardian-
ship when he shall be thereunto required, then
the above obligation is to be void and of no effect
otherwise to be and remain in full force and virtue
in Law.
