Article 1st. I will my soul to God who gave it and my body to the earth to be decently buried, and that my funeral expenses and just debts be paid out of the first means that shall come into the hands of my Executor.

Art 2nd I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Cordelia Ballard the sum of Fifteen hundred (1500.) Dollars to be paid to her out of the means which shall next come into the hand of my Executor.

Art 3rd. I give and bequeath to my daughter Ida Ballard the sum of Twenty four hundred (2400) Dollars to be kept at interest by her Guardian until she shall attain the age of twenty two (22) years; and for Guardian I hereby appoint my son Calvin Ballard.

Art 4th It is my will that my Executor sell (under the direction of the court) the farm



whereon I now live and convey the title in fee simple to the purchaser; being the East half, of the south west quarter of section thirty two (32) in township fifteen (15) north of range two (2) east; and Eight (8) acres off the north end of the east half, of the north west quarter of section five (5) in township fourteen (14) north range two (2) east.

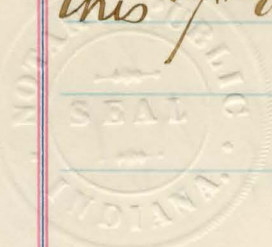

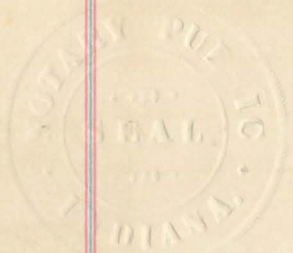


