Said Executor shows to the Court that said decedent died testate having all her property to said Executor and his wife that as shown by a copy of the will filed here with. That her entire estate consisted of two notes executed by said Executor to said decedent in her lifetime amounting to the sum of \$1146.52 that she left no debts which have come to the knowledge of said Executor except for medical services, funeral expenses and the expenses of this administration amounting in all to the sum of \$1042.42. He reports to the Court that he has paid all of said debts and charges and after deducting said debts and charges there remained the sum of \$1042.42 which sum he has paid one half to his wife and taken her receipt there for and that he has retained the other half himself under the provisions of said will.

That he has filed no inventory in said estate because there was nothing to inventory except said two notes.
