Know all men by these presents that we Pemberton
P. Dickson & David Matlock & Samuel Givensall of County
of Hendricks and State of Indiana are held and firmly
bound unto the State of Indiana in the penal sum of
one hundred Dollars lawful money of the
United States for the payment of which well and truly
to be made and done we bind ourselves our heirs &c
Jointly and severally firmly by these presents sealed
^{with} our seals and dated this 11th day of Nov. A.D. 1835

The condition of the above obligation is
such that if the above bound Pemberton P. Dickson will truly
and faithfully discharge the duties and perform the
trusts committed to him as Guardian of the Person
of William Black Infant, who has no parents,

— during
the minority of the said William Black Infant
as aforesaid — and render to this Court a
Just and true account of his said Guardianship
when he shall be thereunto required then this
obligation is to be void and of none effect other
wise to be and remain in full force and virtue
in law,
