<sup>with</sup> our seals and dated this 11<sup>th</sup> day of Nov. AD. 1835

The condition of the above obligation is  
such that if the above bound Pemberton P. S. Dickson will truly  
and faithfully discharge the duties and perform the  
trust committed to him as Guardian of the Person  
of William Black Infant who has no parents,

— during  
the minority of the said William Black Infant  
as aforesaid — and render to this Court a  
just and true account of his said Guardianship  
when he shall be thereunto required that this  
obligation is to be void and of none effect other  
wise to be and remain in full force and virtue  
in law,
