that Whereas the above named Thomas Branough
on the ninth Day of February 1835 entered into a Bond
of two thousand Dollars with one John Mahan ^{& J. F. Insley} as
his security thereto conditioned that the said Thomas
Branough would truly and faithfully discharge the
Duties and perform the trusts committed to him as
Guardian of the Estate of Robert B Branough com-
missioner of the Estate of James Insley during the minority
of the said Robert B Branough and under to this
Court a Just and true account of his Guardianship when he
should be thereto required then the obligation to
be void & Lydia Thomas Branough J. F. Insley & John
Mahan and whereas the said John Mahan on the
11th Day of February 1836 his ~~oath~~ filed his Petition verified by
his oath praying to be discharged from subsequent liability as such
surety and whereas the Court did ~~and~~ adjudge that the said
Thomas Branough as such Guardian should give further and
additional security now therefore if the said Thomas
Branough ~~will~~ faithfully perform the conditions of the
former Bond as above recited then this obligation
