been duly appointed by the Court of Common Pleas of Probate Court of the County of *Merriam* in the State aforesaid, GUARDIAN *of said* *Lusetha Pauline Massey and* *Miriam Brown and* *John Bradley* *heirs to the estate of* *Braslet* *Brown deceased*
