and James Donnard Associate Judges of
the County of Henricks in the sum of
two hundred dollars the payment of which
well and truly to be made witness Our
hands and seals this 21st day of July
A.D. 1827.

The Conditions of the above obligation
is such that whereas Letters Testamentary
have this day issued from the Clerk's
Office in the County of Henricks to the above
bonded Samuel Jessup on the Estate of
Joseph Cloud late of Henricks county
deceased, now should the said Samuel
Jessup well and truly discharge his duty
as administrator as aforesaid then the above
obligation to be void and of none effect
otherwise to remain in full force and
virtue in law and Equity
