one thousand Dollars for the payment of which well and truly
to be made and done we bind ourselves our heirs Executors and
administrators Jointly and severally jointly by these presents
sealed with our seals and dated this 15th day of August 1839

The condition of the above obligation is such
that if the above bound Amos S. Wills and Lewis S. Pounds will
truly and faithfully discharge the duties and perform the trusts
committed to them as Guardians of the persons and Estates of
