A Citizen of Overton County. It appearing to the County Court now in Session that Thomas Davis Sen has died leaving no Will and the Court being satisfied as to your claim to Administration upon his estate and you having given Bond and qualified as directed by law and the Court having ordered that letters of Administration issue to you

These are therefore to Authorize and empower you to take into your possession and Control all the goods Chattels claims and papers of said Estate and return a true and perfect Inventory thereof to our next County Court to collect and pay all debts and to do and transact all the duties in relation to said estate which lawfully devolve on you as Administrator and after having settled up said estate to deliver the residue thereof to those who by law are entitled to the same.
