

my funeral be Conducted in a manner Corresponding
with my estate and Situation in life —
And as to such Worldly estate as it has pleased God
to intrust me with I dispose of the Same in the
following manner To Wit I direct first that all
my Just debts and expences of funeral be paid as
soon after my decease as possible out of the first money
that may come to the hands of my executors and for
that purpose I direct that a fair Valuation or apprais-
-ement be made by three Judicious Neighbours of the
forty acre lot of land lying and being west of the
South half of the Eighty ^{that I now live on} and after being Signed with
their names that a Copy of the Same be Given by
them to each of my executors and to effectuate this my
intention I hereby Vest my executors with full power
and authority to dispose of the said forty acre lot of
land at Twelve months Credit for the best price that
Can be obtained for the purpose of paying of my
debts and other expences and I further Vest in the
hands of my executors the power and authority of
Executing a deed in as full and as complete a manner
as I Could do myself if I was living I also direct
that the whole of my household furniture with all
my Stock and Crops and all my personal Property
of what soever kind it may be shall be and Remain
