D. 1850.

Whereas the above named and bounden *Charles Dours* has been duly appointed by the Probate Court of the County of *Hendricks* in the State aforesaid, GUARDIAN of the estate of *Julia Ann Dours*,

and letters of Guardianship have been duly granted to *him* by said Court. Now therefore the condition of the above obligation, is to the effect following to-wit: That the said *Charles Dours* shall faithfully perform the duties of *his* said trust as such Guardian: Then and in that case said obligation shall be null and void, otherwise to be and remain in full force and virtue in law.
