Know all men by these presents that we Simeon W. Ely
~~and~~ — — William Trotter and John S. Woodard
are held and firmly bound unto the State of Indiana in the
sum of Six hundred dollars for the payment of which
well and truly to be made and done we bind ourselves,
our heirs, executors and administrators jointly & severally,
firmly by these presents, Sealed with our seals and dated
this 26th day of August A.D. 1845.

The condition of the above obligation is such that if the
above bound Simeon Ely shall diligently and faithfully
execute the duties and trusts committed to him as
Administrator of the Estate of David Ely deceased,
and will ~~of~~ obey all orders and decrees of the Probate
Court of Hendricks County, made pursuant to law
touching the administration of the Estate entrusted to
him, then the above obligation is to be void and of
none effect, otherwise to be and remain in full force
and virtue in law. And the Legislature is hereby
authorized to change, modify or repeal any law now in
force, and to enact any and all laws during the existence
of such bond at the pleasure of the legislature, without
in any way or manner releasing said Administrator or
his Sureties.
