The Condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above bounden Robert Thompson has this day taken out Letters of administration on the Estate of Thomas Evans deceased Intestate late of Hendricks County Ia now should the said Robert Thompson faithfully discharge the duties and trust committed to him as such administrator and truly and promptly deliver and pay over to his successor to be appointed by the Hendricks Probate Court if any such should ever be appointed all good chattles chattles rights credits monies and effects which may come into his hands by virtue of the office of administrator aforesaid and do and perform all acts and things agreeably to law touching the premises then and in that case the above obligation to void and of none effect otherwise to remain in full force and virtue in Law and Equity.
