her death indebted to him said Plaintiff in  
the sum of "Three hundred <sup>Seventy one</sup> ~~thirty~~ dollars  
and twenty-five cents" for work & labor  
done by Plaintiff and his wife Eliza  
Jeffers for said deceased and at her request,  
a bill of particulars of which is herewith  
filed and made a part of this complaint. That  
the said (deft) Simon J. Madley Executor as  
aforesaid, of the Estate of Mary Mothershead  
now justly owes the said, which is unpaid  
wherefore said Plaintiff prays that said sum  
of three hundred <sup>Seventy one</sup> ~~thirty~~ dollars & Twenty
