of the estate of Leonard Foster decd, to personally be and appear
before the Honorable the judge of the Probate Court of said
County on the first day of his next term to be holden at the
Court house in the town of Danville, on the second Mon-
day in May next, then and there and to shew cause
why he does not make a report or a final settlement
of said estate. Herein fail not, And have you
then there this writ.
