affirmation says that Rodger Foster, ~~more than fifteen days ago~~
departed this life in said county, intestate, as he believes, on the 10
day of January, 1858; That said Decedent

left a personal estate to be administered, of the probable
value, as he is informed and believes, of not more than
Three hundred dollars, and that the widow relinquishes her right to letters of administration
and further saith not.

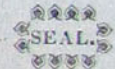

ing as his final report; There came
to his hands as administrator personal
property as per inventory on file in
this Court one hundred and thirty eight
dollars, which said property was
taken by Angelina Foster widow of
said deceased after which her receipt
was filed with said inventory -
and said Administrator further
reports and says that no other
property or effects have come to
his hands or knowledge except
an unliquidated claim against
John W. L. Matlock against whom
the said Administrator commenced
suit in the Hendricks Circuit Court
and which suit is still undetermined
and the said Administrator further
says that the said John W. L. Matlock
has become, and is hopelessly insol-
vent and that no benefit could
arise to said Estate by the prosecution
of said claim and that said Admin-
istrator has no means in his hands
or the prospect of any from said estate
to enable him to prosecute said claim
any further, he therefore prays that
the Hon^{ble} Court will release him from
the further prosecution of said suit

and accept this as his final report
