ORDER ON FINAL SETTLEMENT.

Comes now, Jesse H. Blair administrator of said estate, and submits to the court the account and vouchers by him filed in final settlement thereof on the 17<sup>th</sup> day of *Nov*, 1897, and also files and submits proofs of the posting and publication of notices to the creditors, heirs at law and all others interested in said estate, of the filing of said account and vouchers, and when the same would be heard, which notices and proofs the court, on examination, holds to be sufficient, and that said account and matters connected therewith are now properly before the court for final action thereon; said account, notices and proofs are in these words (here insert); and the court having examined the said account and vouchers and heard evidence relating thereto finds that more than one year has elapsed since the granting of letters upon said estate and the giving of notice thereof; that said administrator over and above all credits by him claimed he is chargeable with no balance whatever, ~~xx xxxxxxxxxxxxx xxx xxx-~~ ~~xxxx of said estate~~ and that he has paid all the debts and liabilities and taxes of said estate and fully administered the same And the court now allows the credits claimed by said administrator in his said account. The court further finds from the statement of said administrator filed with or contained in said account and from proof heard in support thereof that there remain after administration, and of which said Job Hadley died seized in fee-simple, the following described real estate situated in Hendrick County, Indiana, to wit:

Part of the East half of section fifteen (15)



and part of the West half of section fourteen (14) all in Township seventeen (17) North, in Range one (1) West, described as follows: Commencing at the Northwest corner of the Northeast quarter of section fifteen (15) Township seventeen (17) North in Range one (1) West, and running thence South about one hundred and sixty-nine (169) rods and twenty-eight (28) links to the centre of the main ditch in prairie, thence South seventy-nine (79) degrees East about one hundred and sixty-four (164) rods with the centre of said ditch to the section line between sections fourteen (14) and fifteen (15); thence South seventy-nine and one-half ( $79 \frac{1}{2}$ ) degrees East about eighty-one (81) rods and five (5) links still with said ditch to the line dividing the Southwest quarter of said section fourteen (14) to a point twenty-two (22) rods and three (3) links North of the centre of said quarter; thence North two hundred and eighteen and one-half ( $218 \frac{1}{2}$ ) rods to the North line of the Northwest quarter of said section fourteen (14); thence West about two hundred and forty (240) rods to the place of beginning, containing two hundred and ninety-four and one-quarter ( $294 \frac{1}{4}$ ) acres more or less.

That said Job Hadley left surviving him as his sole and only heir at law his widow Tacy Hadley to whom at his death and such heir at law said real estate descended in fee-simple.

And this Court further finds that said administrator has made satisfactory arrangements with said Tacy Hadley sole heir herein for his compensation for his services and expenses rendered herein.

The East half of the South East quarter of Section twenty one(21) Township seventeen (17) North Range one(1) West containing eighty(80) acres more or less. That on said day he was assessed as the owner

of said land for the construction of 130 feet or 356 cubic yards of a certain ditch known as the Seven Mile Prairie Ditch. That afterwards, to-wit on the day of December 1876, the said plaintiff and the said Job Hadley entered into a certain contract whereby this plaintiff was to deliver to said Hadley a certain horse, bridle and saddle, the property of plaintiff and in consideration thereof said Hadley was to perform all the work required of plaintiff on said ditch and save plaintiff harmless on account thereof.

That in pursuance of said agreement this plaintiff delivered to said Hadley the said horse, bridle and saddle and the said Hadley delivered to plaintiff a certain written obligation to do and perform all the conditions on his part to be performed as above set out.

That said written obligation has been lost, and although plaintiff has made diligent search therefor, he has been unable to find the same.



That said Job Hadley wholly failed to dig said ditch or to have the same done, and failed to save plaintiff harmless, and afterwards this plaintiff was compelled to and did pay to the ditch commissioners of said County the sum of \$100. on account thereof. That afterwards, on the 5th day of November 1884 the said Hadley paid to plaintiff on account of said contract, the sum of \$12. and although requested as to do has failed to pay the balance thereof. That there is now due thereon to plaintiff the sum of \$88. principal and \$75. interest thereon.

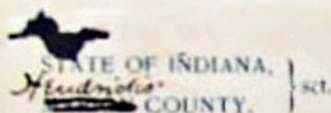
