Your petitioner
Emma Hadley of the County of Hendricks
and State of Indiana would represent
unto your Honor that heretofore to wit
on the day of A.D. 1861 one
John A Hadley departed this life in
said County of Hendricks leaving
your petitioner his widow and one child
Eugene A Hadley his son who is under
the age of twenty one and who is an infant
and that they are his ^{only} heirs at law and
legal representatives him surviving and
your petitioner would further represent that
the said John A Hadley died seized of
the following described lands to wit
The West half of the North East quarter
of Section Seven in Township fifteen
Range one West containing eighty
acres. Also the following tract of land
Commencing at the North East Corner of
the North West fractional quarter of
said Section Township and range aforesaid
thence west on Section line eight
