On taking an Inventory I found property
as appraised to the amount of \$409.65

The sale of what was sold fell
short of the appraisement 5.45

Leaving the amount of the Estate 404.20

There was also four notes found, on one
Chambers Headly in Ohio secured by a mortgage
on Land which were considered doubtful in
consequence of the title to said Land being in
dispute one of which notes is not yet due

The total amount of said notes at the time
of taking the Inventory was \$1198.38

I find the Estate in debt about \$190.00

Now I suppose that it will take about
the \$404.20 to pay the widows \$300 and
expenses of Administration and general
charges

Now the object of my coming before this
Court is to represent that through assistance of
the family connexion of the above named Chambers
Headly who was brother to the deceased I can
make an arrangement by which \$235 can be
collected on the above doubtful claims sufficient
to cause the estate to be settled as a solvent estate
provided that there can be such a compound of
the matter made as to put off the collection
of the balance of said doubtful claims till
the minor children of the deceased should be of lawful
age to receive their Estate or till the law suit about

the title of said land is settled by said
Chambers & Hadley giving notes to the widow for her
one third of the balance of said claims and note
for the use and benefit of the minor heirs of
said Lind by Hadley for their legal portion of
said claim at six percent compound interest
secured by mortgage on the same land which
has not been further incumbered than it was
when the other mortgage was taken

This arrangement being by the council and
satisfactory to the parties I ask the Court to
accept this report and authorize me to close up
such an arrangement
