Report of Administrator
(To the Honorable Joshua L Adams
Judge of said Court)

The undersigned Adminis-
trator of the Estate of said Zeno Hadley
respectfully reports and states to the
Court - That said deceased left
a personal Estate amounting to
about the sum of \$13000. Consisting in
much the largest part of stock in
a Banking Company and money at
interest - That he left no widow and
only the following heirs at law Court:
his Sons Joshua and Milton Hadley
his daughters Jane H Doan and Matilda
H Kellum - and one Grand Son
Rowland H Hill, who inherit his Es-
tate in Equal parts, one fifth each.
That the four Children above named
are all adults and competent to act
for themselves with reference to the dis-
tribution of said Estate - That said Grand
Son, Rowland H Hill has a Guardian
one Samuel B Hill, duly appointed &
qualified, and competent to act for his
ward in the premises - That before the

appointment of the undersigned as administrator of said Estate. said adult heirs and the Guardian of said minor had by agreement with each other and among themselves, made distribution of the entire personal Estate, and that it was upon the request of said parties that the undersigned was appointed as administrator and solely for the purpose of legally transferring and delivering over to said heirs the property of said Estate pursuant to their agreement and distribution thereof - That because of the facts aforesaid it is not necessary or practicable to make any Inventory or Sale of said property as required by law, wherefore he has ratified and approved of the distribution so made as shown by the acknowledge^{ment} & receipt of said several heirs at law which is filed herein.

Said Administrator would further state that there are no debts outstanding against said Estate and no person interested therein except the heirs at law aforesaid, but that in the event there might possibly be presented some claim against said Estate he has given public notice of his appointment as required by law and holds himself responsible as administrator for the

payment of any just debt which may hereafter be presented & admitted or proven against the same, and he has also taken the written agreement of said heirs at law holding themselves responsible to creditors.

Wherefore he prays the Court to ratify and approve this Report subject to the rights of creditors and to accept the same as a sufficient reason for his failure to make Inventory and sale, And to continue this Estate for twelve months with leave to creditors if there be any to file and establish their Claims and if none be then filed to accept and confirm this Report as a full and final Report of the undersigned as Administrator of said Estate and of the settlement thereof and the distribution of the Surplus among the heirs at law — Respectfully Submitted
