Know all men by these presents that we John
Hedge, David Hedge and Joseph Robins
of the County of Hendricks in the State of Indiana are
held and firmly bound unto the said State of
Indiana in the penal sum of One hundred & seventy Dollars
Lawful money of the United States for the payment
of which well and truly to be made and done we bind
ourselves our heirs Executors and Administrator Jointly
and severally firmly by these presents sealed with our seals
and dated this the 15th day of February 1837

The condition of the above obligation is such
that if the above bound John Hedge will truly
and faithfully discharge the duties and perform the
trusts committed to him as guardian of the Estate of
William H. Hedge minor heir to the Estate of
William Hedge, late of Hendricks County deceased
during the minority of the said William H. Hedge
and render to this Court a just and true account of his
Guardianship when he shall be thereunto required
then the above obligation is to be void and of none effect
otherwise to be and remain in full force and virtue in Law

H. Hedge having attained my age of twenty one years
do hereby acknowledge that I have this day Received
of John Hedge my guardian duly appointed by the
probate Court of Hendricks County the sum of three
hundred dollars in full satisfaction and payment of
my share of the estate real and personal of my late
father William Hedge deceased I do therefore by these
presents release acquit and forever discharge the said
John Hedge his heirs executors and administrators from
the said guardian ship and from all actions suits ~~Reckings~~
arings claims and demands whatever for or by reason
there of or of any other act matter Cause or thing what
soever from the Beginning of the world untill this date
given under my hand and Seal this 10 day of June 1842
