I Leviak Hults of the County of Marion State of Indiana Yoman - do make and publish this my Last Will and Testament in the forme and manner following.

Item 1st I do give to my son Daniel C one Hundred acres of Land on the West part of Section twenty nine and to run so far East on the Section line as to contain one hundred acres without interfaining with the land that mite be drowned or floced by water with raising a dam twelve feet high at the place called the mill scate to him his heirs and assigns for Ever -

Item 2^d I due give to my two daughters Charity and Abigail one hundred acres on the East parte of Section twenty eight adjoining the lands of James L Givens - to them their heirs and assigns for Ever and if either of them die before they should come of age the surviving ones shall have the others half -

Item 3^d I do give to my son Nathaniel W. One hundred acres of Land adjoining the Land of Charity and Abigail and the lines to run parallel with the North and South lines of the sections to him his Heirs and assigns for Ever -

Item 4th I due give to my two daughters Annas and Gerusha one Dollar each to be paid when sold for -

Item 5th I due give to my son Amiah S. the Moneys left in the hands of Nathan Hulse to collect for me and me to be at the trobel of going after it -

also the Surviving Instruments and Books that be-
-long to the same. and a book for the learning of
Bookkeeping and a Pistol Gun that is call his.
the Money before mentioned is about two hundred
Dollars be the same more or less — — — — —

gltm 6th I due give to Salalahorish fifty acers of Land
-joining The Lands of Nathaniel W on the West
Side to her and her heires and assigns for Ever
after her Mother deceas — — — — —

gltm 7th I due Give to my Cinde and Loving Wife Abigail
the Use of all the Remainder of my Land Which
I know live and Salalahorish Land To Inabel her
to Bring up the Infant Children and my Grand
son Silas the son of Nathaniel W which is to
live with her in a praiseworthy manner
and to Give him deason Education fit for
ducing Business as far as her situation will ad-
-mit also all my personal property of Every
description for the above use and her supports
Excepting what is given to my son Amiah
and at her deceas My Grand son Silas Natha-
-iel W son shall have the Remainder of my
Land Which I due Give to him and her heires
and assigns for Ever Reserving a home and
Supporte for Salalahorish so long as she shall live
un married and in Case my Wife should die
before the above Infant children should Come
of age or marry they shall be brought up
as above directed and the personal property
shall be at her disposal at her deceas what

shall remain over and above bringing up the
said Children and if Charity Abigail or Salamo-
rick should die before they should come of age or
have a lawfull heir their Land shall be divided
between the surviving two - and if my grand son
Silas should die without a lawfull heir his Land
shall be Equally divided between his father Nathaniel
- W. Charity Abigail and Salammack or the survi-
- ving ones of them and in Case one of the girls
should Marry my Executors or their Mother ma-
give them twentyfive Dollars in furniture
if she thinks best so to due

Item 8 Lastly I doe ordain and apoint and constitute
My wife Abigail My son Nathaniel W. and Jeremiah
Corbelly Executors to this my last Will and testa-
- ment and doe hereby Revoke all other wills
and doe acknowlege this onely to stand in force
and Virtue - Signed Sealed and delivered in
the presence of this twentyeighth day
of August in the year of our Lord Christ
one thousand Eight hundred and twenty two

of said estate agreeable to the tenor and effect
of said will, then and in that case the above ob-
ligation shall be void and of none effect, other-
wise to remain in full force and virtue
