D. 1837. Whereas the above named and bounden *Zimri Hunt* has been duly appointed by the *Clerk of the* Probate Court of the County of *Hendricks* in the State of Indiana, *Administrator* of the estate of *Ethamer Hunt* late of said county, deceased, and is about to receive letters of administration as such *Administrator*, which have been duly granted to him by said *Clerk*.

Now therefore the condition of the above obligation, is to the effect following to-wit: that the said *Zimri Hunt* shall diligently and faithfully execute the duties and trusts committed to him as such *administrator*, and that he will obey all orders and decrees of the Probate Court of said county of *Hendricks* made pursuant to law, touching the administration of the estate entrusted to him then and in that case said obligation shall be null and void, otherwise remain in full force and virtue in law.
