as such Guardians





firmly by these presents. Sealed with our seals
and dated this 14th day of May 1838

The condition of the above obligation is such
that if the above bound James McClure and Priscilla
Jackson will truly and faithfully discharge the duties
and perform the trusts committed to them as guardian
of the persons and estates of John Jackson, William
Jackson and Mary Jackson, infants sons and
Daughter of ~~John~~ Elihu Jackson deceased, during
the minority of the said John, William and Mary
and render to this Court a Just and true account
of their said guardianship when they shall be thereunto
required, then the above obligation is to be void and
of none effect, otherwise to be and remain in full
