Mendick, County 3 of said County, greeting.

You are hereby
Commanded to Summons Merry Hobbs, Hugh Bondy and
Rodney Prinstead to be and appear before the Judges
of the Mendick, Circuit Court on the first day of their
next term, to be holden at the Court House in Danville
on the first Monday in October next, then and there to
testify in behalf of the Plaintiff in a Cause pending
in said Court wherein the State of Indiana is plain-
-tiff and William Loys is defendant. This they may
not omit at their Peril And have you then
these this writ.
