You are hereby commanded
to ~~Cite~~ George Merritt to personally be and appear
before the Honorable the judge of the Probate Court of
Hendricks County on the first day of his next term
to be holden at the Court house in the town of Dan-
ville, on the second Monday in ~~February~~ May next
then and there to settle the guardianship
of Charles Merritt of whom he the said George
Merritt is guardian. Merain fail not.
And have you then there this writ.

of said Court, at Danville, this
24th day of February A.D. 1832
