I know all men by these presents that we
Solomon Blair Abner Blair and Enock Jessup all
of the county of Hendricks and State of Indiana are held
and firmly bound unto the State of Indiana in the
sum of four hundred dollars, for the payment of which
well and truly to be made and done we bind our-
selves our heirs executors and administrators Jointly
and Severally firmly by these presents, Sealed with our
Seals and dated this 23rd day of July A.D. 1833

The Condition of the above obligation is such
that if the above bound Solomon and Abner Blair
~~and Enock Jessup~~ will truly and faithfully discharge
the duties and trusts committed to them as executors
of the last will and testament of Ann Milliken
deceased, and will truly and promptly deliver over to
their successors to be appointed by the probate court
of said County should any such successors ever hereafter
be appointed, all such estate goods chattels and assets
and assign to such successors all such rights and
credits as shall of right belong to such successors upon
reasonable demand made thereof then the above
obligation to be void and of none effect otherwise
to be and remain in full force and virtue in law
