Administrators are required, among other duties:

1. To take an inventory and appraisement of the personal estate of the deceased within sixty days from the issuing of letters, and file the same in the Clerk's Office within thirty days after taken; such inventory must show the value of each piece of property, and the aggregate value, and must be made out on a printed blank prepared under the law, a copy of which inventory must be kept by administrators.
 2. To return and file in the Clerk's Office the proper bills of sale of such personal property within thirty days after such sale; the sale bill must show the aggregate amount of the sales, as well as the price for which each article sold, and must also give a list of the articles subject to sale and remaining unsold. (See blanks.)
 3. If no sale is had within the time fixed by law, to report to the Court the reason thereof.
 4. To make a report at the expiration of one year from the date of letters, and at such times thereafter as the Court may direct.
 5. To file in the Clerk's Office, at the expiration of the first six months, and each six months thereafter, an account of all moneys received.


