of Hendricks County Greeting.

You are hereby Commanded to cite
Benjamin A. Moberly, Executor of the estate of John Moberly
deceased, to personally be and appear before the Hon-
orable judge of the Court of Common Pleas of Hendricks County
on the Calling of said estate, at the next term, to be held
at the Court House in the town of Danville, then and
there to make a full and final settlement of said
estate or shew good cause why the same shall
not be done.
