and letters of Guardianship have been duly granted to him by said Court

Now therefore the condition of the above obligation, is to the effect following to-wit: That the said

Benjamin A. Moberly shall faithfully per-
form the duties of his said trust as such Guardian: Then and in that case said obligation
shall be null and void, otherwise to be and remain in full force and virtue in law.
