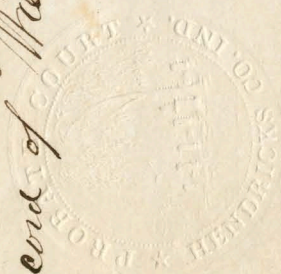

I H Ezekiah Morgan of the County of Hendricks and State of Indiana being weak in body but sound in mind and memory, do make and publish this my last Will and Testament, in manner and form following (to wit).

1st. It is my will that all my just debts and funeral expences be paid.

2nd. It is my will that my beloved wife Eunice have the entire use and benefit of the farm on which I now live, subject to the provision in Item 3rd. and all of my personal property of every description, excepting so much as may be required to pay all just debts against my estate, during her natural life or widowhood, for her comfortable support and to enable her to raise and educate our children, and if she my said wife Eunice should at any time think proper to marry again, it is my will that she have two beds, bedsteads and bedding, two cows, one horse saddle and bridle, the Bureau, large Table and the kitchen furniture.

3rd. It is my will that the tract of land on which I now live be equally divided among my children (namely) Elehu H. William H. and Abadiah H., the division to be made in a manner best calculated to promote the interest of said children when they shall arrive at a lawful age to have it, having respect to an provision made for the comfortable maintenance of my wife Eunice if she should be living and remain my widow, the remainder of my personal estate to be divided in like manner.

4th. I do nominate and appoint my friend Temple

Montgomery Sole Executor of this my last will and testament.
