Shadricks County) the Honorable the Judge of the Superior
Probate Court, of the County and State aforesaid now in
Session at the time aforesaid have Petitioners
for partition of the following named real estate
of which Shadricks Morris died seized intestate
viz: Atkin Morris Widow of the said Shadricks
Morris deceased William Morris Jacob Wilson
and Elizabeth his wife and Morris Wiley Morris
who are all of lawful age, Sidon Morris
Shadricks Morris Sarah Morris Mary Morris
and Nancy Morris who are all infants and
lawful age by Wiley Morris their legal
Guardian, who are all of the legal heirs and
legitimates of the Estate of Shadricks Morris deceased
intestate,

Pray your Honours to appoint Commissioners
according to the Statute in such Cases made and
provided to make partition of the following
named Real Estate (viz) The west half of the
South East quarter of Section one in Township
fifteen North of Range one East and the East half
of the South West quarter ^{of Section} one in Township fifteen
and the west half of the North East quarter
of Section twelve and also the East half of the

Indiana: James M. Hagg, William Payne & Abram
Harding Commissioners appointed by the Probate Court
aforesaid, at the May term thereof 1835. to make Partition
of the real estate of Shadrick Morris deceased, report as
follows, to wit: That on the 8th day of August 1835 they met
on the premises of the said deceased, to wit, The West half
of the Northeast quarter & the East, Southeast quarter of Section
one in Township fifteen North, of Range One East, and
the West half of the Northeast quarter, & the East half of the
Northwest quarter of Section twelve ~~in~~ in the above said
Township & Range; and after being duly notified
did proceed and lay off the premises aforesaid as
follows, to wit, To Nancy Morris widow of the said
Shadrick, the East half of the Northwest quarter of said
Section twelve, during her natural life, then to divide
to Lidian Morris & Shadrick Morris Infant heirs,
of the said Shadrick Morris deceased

1st To Jane Morris an heir of lawful age, the
West half of the West half of the Northeast quarter of
Section twelve in said Township containing forty
Acres and twenty five hundredths, which we value
to be worth One dollar & Seventy five cents per Acre
amounting to the sum of $\$10.43\frac{3}{4}$ and known
on the plat hereto annexed by Lot No 1

2nd To Sarah Morris an Infant heir, the East
half of the West half of the Northeast quarter of Section
twelve in said Township, containing forty Acres
& twenty ^{five} hundredths, valued to be worth one dollar
& Seventy five cents per Acre, amounting to $\$10.43\frac{3}{4}$
and known on the plat aforesaid by Lot No 2

The Land lying in Section One, to wit, the
West half of the Northeast quarter & the East half South
West quarter of said Section one in Township fifteen North
of Range one East, we have divided into five

equal parts by lines running North & South with the section
bearing as will be seen on the annexed plat numbered
as follows ~~town~~, commencing on the East side with
Number 1 & running West 5, 6, 7 & 8 each lot
containing thirty two Acres. Lots Nos 4, 5, & 6 are
valued to be worth One dollar & seventy cents per Acre
and Lots ~~7~~ 7 & 8 to be worth two dollars & fifty
cents per Acre assigned to the heirs as follows, ~~town~~,

4th To Wiley Morris an heir of Lawful age
Lot No 4, containing thirty two Acres at one
dollar & seventy five cents per Acre amounting
to ~~forty~~ ^{forty} six dollar \$66.00 \$56.00

5th To Nancy Morris an Infant heir, Lot No 5
containing thirty ~~thirty~~ two Acres at One dollar
& seventy five cents per Acre amounting to \$56.00

6th To Mary Morris an Infant heir, Lot
No 6 containing thirty two Acres at \$1.75 per
Acre amounting to the sum of \$56.00

7th To Jacob Wilson & his wife Elizabeth
heirs of Lawful age Lot No 7 containing thirty
two Acres at two dollars & fifty cents per Acre
amounting to the sum of \$80.00

8th To William Morris an heir of Lawful
age Lot No 8, containing thirty two Acres, at
two dollars and ~~and~~ fifty cents per Acre
amounting to the sum of \$80.00

Your Petitioners for Partition of the following, real Estate of which Shadrick Morris died seized Intestate, viz. Nancy Morris of the said Shadrick Morris deceased, William Morris, Jacob Wilson and Elizabeth his wife, Jane Morris & Wiley Morris who are all of lawful age, Gideon Morris Shadrick Morris, Sarah Morris & Mary Morris and Wm. Morris who are all infants under the lawful age by Wiley Morris their Lawful Guardian, who are all of the legal heirs and legates of the Estate of Shadrick Morris deceased Intestate Pray your Honour to appoint commissioners according to the Statute in such case made and provided to make partition of the following named real Estate (viz) the west half of the South East quarter of section one in Township fifteen North of Range one East and the East half of the South west quarter of section one in Township fifteen and the west half of the North East quarter of section Twelve and also the East half of the North west quarter of section Twelve in said range In the following manner (viz) to Nancy Morris Widow of Shadrick Morris deceased the one fourth part thereof during her natural life of said real Estate then to descend to Gideon

Morris and Shadrach Morris Infant heirs of the said
Shadrach were deceased as their full part of the said
real Estate aforesaid. by Wiley Morris their Guardian
by agreement the widow and the said Wiley Morris
their Guardian and other heirs) and to William
Morris Jacob Wilson and his wife Elizabeth, Wiley
Morris Jane Morris all being of lawful age and
Sarah Morris, Mary Morris and Mary Morris
Morris under the age of twenty one years (by
Wiley Morris their Guardian) the remaining three fourths

thereof according to Law.
