THE GRAND JURORS for the State of Indiana, empannelled, sworn, and charged to inquire within and for the body of the County of *Hendricks* aforesaid, upon their oath present, that *John Nelson* late of said County, on the *first* day of *October* in the year Eighteen Hundred and Forty *Seven* in the County aforesaid,

did then and there unlawfully lose to one John Paine then and there being a part of his said Alex John Nelsons interest in a certain interest of the value of fifty cents by then and there unlawfully betting and wagering with the said John Paine Alexander Tracey David Chandel Garland Smith John Hedge Lemmick Robbins Andrew J Lower and one Blake whose christian name to the Grand Jurors aforesaid is unknown on the result of a certain wager to be then and there determined by shooting at a mark which said wager was then and there determined

contrary to the form of the Statute in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Indiana.
