To the Sheriff of *Hendricks* County--Greeting:You are hereby commanded to cite *Benjamin Hiatt**Administrator*

of the estate of *Edward Newman* late of said
county of *Hendricks*, deceased, if *he* may be found in your bailiwick
to be and appear before the Court of Common Pleas of said county, on *Tuesday*
the *Ind* day of the next term of said Court, to be begun and held at the
Court House in *Danville*, on the *Ind* Monday in *November, 1858*
then and there to render to said Court account of *his* administration,
under oath; Showing, First, clearly and succinctly, the entire aggregate amount of such
