the undersigned Guardian of the estate of
the Minor heirs of the estate of Simeon R
Paine's estate would respectfully report that
he has received a note on Peter Curtes assigned
to him by John Bohannon for Due on the
Twenty fifth of December AD 1841.

the amount of said note is eight hundred
and fifty dollars. on the said note is indorsed
a credit of ten Dollars. which note is
in the hands of S J Hadley the said
Hadley is to retain three hundred dollars out
of said note and return the balance
of said note on the money to the said
Guardians of the said minor heirs.

five hundred and thirty five dollars and
fifty cents out of the Proceeds of said note
belong to said minor heirs in payment
of the Lands sold by the said Guardian
which said note has been on interest at
six percent interest ever since the 25th of
December AD 1841
