The administrator also shows that there is a controversy between Mary E. Pear, the widow,



and the residuary legatee as to whether she, the widow, is entitled to the statutory provision of \$500.<sup>00</sup> to widows, notwithstanding the will, and he does not attempt to decide the same but pay the money into court for the adjudication of the court.

He says he has fully executed the will of decedent so far as the same devolves on him as Executor; he has paid the debts and collected the assets.

Wherefore he asks to be discharged from his bond and trust.
