sum of Eighty four dollars lawful money
of the United States for the payment of which well and
truly to be made and done we bind ourselves our heirs Executors
and Administrators Jointly and severally firmly by these
presents sealed with our seals and dated this the 21st
day of November A 1836

The condition of the obligation is such
that if the above bound Nathan Meredith will truly
and faithfully discharge the duties and perform the trusts
committed to him as guardian of the person and estate
of Alfred B Pegg during the minority
of the said Alfred B Pegg

and render to this Court a just and true account
of his said Guardianship when he shall be thereunto required
then the above obligation is to be void and of none effect otherwise
to be and remain in full force and virtue in Law
