Perry Nolan, Guardian of Polly Ann Porter and James
K P Porter, ^{aged thirteen and fifteen respectively} infant children of Elizabeth Morgan by Samuel
Porter, her former husband, sheweth unto your honor that after
the death of said Samuel ~~and~~ Elizabeth, intermarried with one
Joseph Morgan, her present husband, that for the purpose
of securing a competency for the maintenance and support of
said infants, the said Elizabeth and Joseph Morgan
agreed to pay to said infants the sum of six hundred dollars,
at the time of their death, and to secure the payment of said
sum of six hundred dollars, the said Joseph and Elizabeth
Morgan made, executed and delivered to said infant, their
certain deed of mortgage, bearing date the 13th day of Octo-
ber, 1855, and thereby conveyed to said Polly and
James infants as aforesaid, the east half of the south west
quarter of section ten (10) in township seven (7) north,
of range three (3) west, in the County of Montgomery,
and State of Indiana, to secure to them, the said Polly
and James, the payment of the said sum of six
hundred dollars, due and payable at the death of
said Joseph and Elizabeth Morgan, which mortgage
is now in full force and virtue in law. And
said Perry Nolan says that he has been appointed
by this Court, and now is the guardian of said
infants, who are still within the age of twenty one
years; that said Joseph and Elizabeth Morgan have
sold and conveyed said land to John R. Pelly,

subject to the payment of said sum of six hundred dollars,
payable as aforesaid, at the death of said Joseph and Elizabeth;
that said Joseph Morgan is about 32 years of age and Eliza-
beth is about 33 years of age, each of whom are robust
and healthy; that they, said Joseph and Elizabeth,
as well as said Pelly are desirous of removing the incumbrance
of said mortgage off of said land, and to effect that purpose,
propose to pay to said Perry Coland, as the guardian
aforesaid, the sum of Four Hundred Dollars cash in
hand, in full discharge of said Mortgage, and said
Guardian being well satisfied that the said sum of
Four Hundred Dollars, loaned and put at interest for
and during the lifetime of said Joseph and Eliza-
beth, will, in all probability, amount to a much larger
sum than six hundred dollars, and that his said
wards would largely be benefitted by said change,
and arrangement; he said Guardian does pray your
honor to grant an order, directing him to receive of and
from the said Joseph and Elizabeth Morgan, the said
sum of Four Hundred Dollars in full satisfaction
and discharge of said Mortgage. And that in consideration
thereof, he be authorized to enter the same of record,

his complaint and petition - and said Guardian further represents that one of said Wards Dnt; Polly Ann Porter is an idiot, and nearly blind - that she is subject to fits - that her state would have been exhausted long since in taking care of - procuring medical services and supporting said Ward had not her friends furnished means for such purposes -

that James K P Porter is bordering on the same state of mind - that although fifteen years old he is unable to take care of himself and will in all probability not be able to take care of himself in the future - that said Guardian fully believes the sum of four hundred Dollars loaned at interest would be a much better investment and realize a great deal more to them than if continued as at present and that it is also quite probable said Wards will never receive anything from their interest in said Real Estate unless sold for the price above named - wherefore he prays the Court to make an order directing him to receive said sum and enter satisfaction of said Mortgage



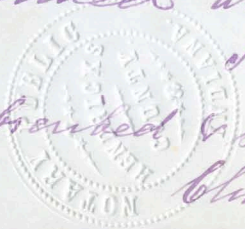
