




That the object in taking out letters of guardianship was that he might obtain from the Government of the United States a pension believed to be due the said John Powell, by reason of the death of his father in the service of the U. S. in the late war.

He says that his ward is now of the full age of twenty one years; that he never received for his ward any pension, nor any sum whatever from any source.
