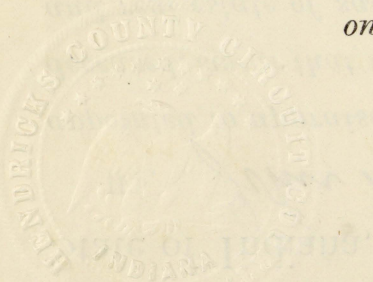
Whereas, *Eliza Price*, Widow and relict of
