

Indiana in the sum of two thousand Dollars  
for the payment of which well and truly to be  
made and done we bind ourselves our heirs  
Executors and administrators jointly and severally  
firmly by these presents sealed with our seals un-  
dated this 12<sup>th</sup> day of August A.D. 1833

The condition of the above obligation  
is such that if the above bound Catharine Ramsey  
Executrix and David Jones Executor will truly and faithfully  
discharge the duties and trust committed to them  
as Executor & Executrix of the last will and  
testament of Bartholomew Ramsey deceased accor-  
ding to the Law then and in that case the  
above obligation is void and of none effect  
otherwise to be and remain in full  
force and virtue in Law —

I Bartholomew Ramsey, of the County of  
Hendricks and State of Indiana do make ordain  
and publish this my last will and testament  
I direct first that all my just debts and funeral  
expences together with all lawful charges, be paid  
as soon after my decease as possible out of the first  
moneys that shall come in to the hands of my  
executors, from any portion of my estate real or  
personal. I direct that my wife Catharine  
shall have the west half of the north west quarter  
of Section no. twenty three Township fourteen north  
of Range one east and the east half of the north  
east quarter of Section no. twenty two Township  
and Range aforesaid. during her life time, or her  
being my widow also, all of my personal estate after  
paying off my heirs hereafter mentioned, and at her  
death or expiration of widowhood, my real and personal  
estate, aforesaid, to be sold and equally divided among-  
st my children - I will and bequeath unto my  
daughter Elizabeth Jones one dollar - I will and  
bequeath unto my son James Ramsey twenty dollars  
I will and bequeath unto my daughter Nancy Jones  
one dollar I will and bequeath unto my son  
Samuel Ramsey sixty one dollars I will and bequeath  
unto my son John Ramsey sixty one dollars, I will  
and bequeath unto my daughter Sarah Jane Ramsey  
Sixty one dollars, I will and bequeath unto my  
son Daniel Ramsey sixty one dollars. And I  
herely make and ordain my wife Catharine executrix



and David Jones executor of this my last will  
and testament. In witness whereof, I, Bartholamew  
Ramsey the testator, have hereunto set my hand and  
seal, this fifteenth day of June in the year of our  
Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty three
